

TOWN OF FREEPORT OFFERS FOOD SCRAP DROP-OFF PROGRAM

Freeport residents visiting the Hedgehog Mountain Road transfer facility can now compost their food scraps free of charge!

Simply bring your food scraps in a separate bucket or container during your regular trip to the transfer facility. At the transfer facility, just deposit your food scraps into the designated compost totes.

The food waste will be collected by a local composting company, We Compost It! and converted to compost. Compost will be donated to our local Freeport Schools.

Acceptable food scraps are listed on the back and include meat and fish.
